Samples ideas from the Teacher's Guide

Pre-reading discussion:

What do we call the day you were born?
How many of you have a birthday?
Did you know animals have birthdays too?

Post reading discussions:

In the story, why do you think Mori is so sad?
Would you be sad if your friends didn't wish you a Happy Birthday?

Language Arts:

What is your favorite animal at the zoo? Write a poem using the letters of the name of the animal.

Cross word puzzles – in activity book in English and Spanish (1-3)

Math:

Paint by number simple addition – in activity book (1-3)

What things would you need to buy if you were planning a Birthday party for someone?

Science:

Plan a visit to the local zoo. If there is no local zoo, create a zoo in the classroom.

Have the students make masks of the different animals or draw pictures of them and put them up around the classroom.

What are some of the things that an animal keeper does?

They are responsible for the well being of all animals under their care.

This means:

1. Feeding them healthy diets.
2. Cleaning their areas so they have a clean place to live.
3. Health and well being. They do have vets at zoos and the keeper needs to work with the vet to keep the animals healthy. They do this by giving medications when needed and keeping an eye on the animals and letting the vet know when something looks like it could be a problem for the animals. They also assist the vet during examinations.

How long do they usually live?

Okapi – over 30 years

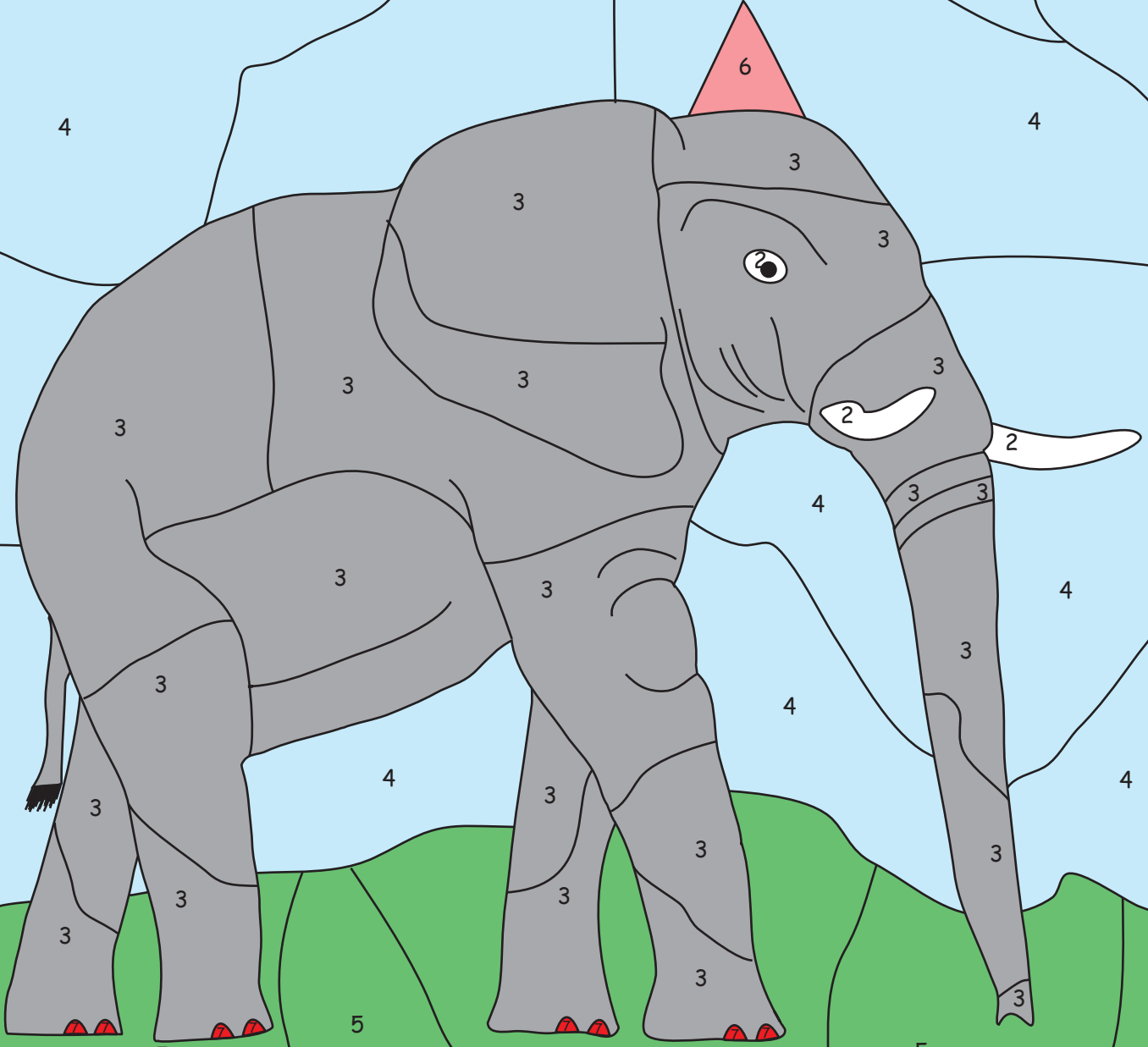
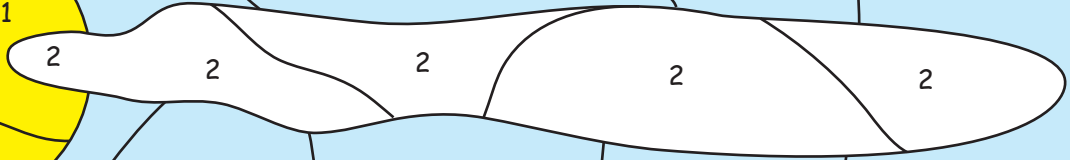
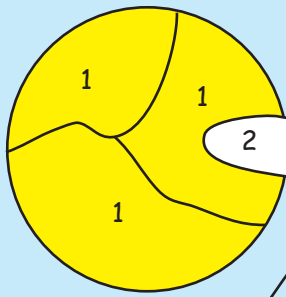
Gerenuk – 10–12 years

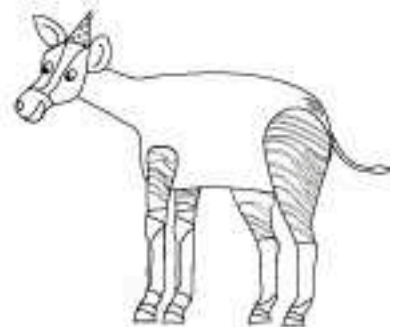
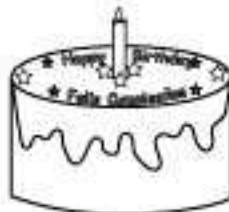
